- Leadership training stresses the development of goal setting, problem solving and decision making skills.

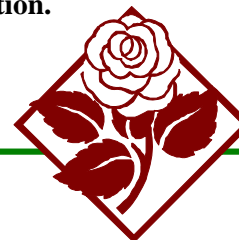

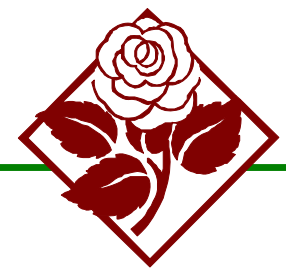
