This year’s New York State project pays homage to the **Community Service National Program!** We challenge you to complete three different community service events this year. Chapter members that participate will have the opportunity to brainstorm community service projects with three different focuses: people, animals, and nature.

October 1st, 2022- November 20th, 2022: Focus on People
November 21st, 2022- January 9th, 2023: Focus on Animals
January 10th, 2023- February 28th, 2023: Focus on Nature

Each community service project would last for approximately 50 days from October 1st, 2022- February 28th, 2023. Before March 1st, chapters would submit a 30-second to a 2-minute video explaining ALL THREE of their projects via email. Please also make sure to include photos of your projects in your videos so viewers have a visual idea of what your project was like. The top three submissions will be featured live at the State conference, while all participants will receive recognition for their hard work on their projects!

Video Rules

- **Must be submitted before March 1st, 2023**
- **Must include ALL THREE community service projects categories**
- **30 seconds to 2 minutes in length**
- **Include pictures and/or videos from your event**
- **Include a narrative description of who, what, when, where, and why!**
- **Clearly state your chapter name in the video**
- **Advisers should be the ones emailing the complete video**
- **The subject line should read “NYS FCCLA Community Legacy Project”**
